Within two months of opening Club 180 Ministry, we were given the opportunity to become sole operators of the ministry and become our own 501c3 organization. Then within a year of serving, God allowed us to purchase a 25,000 sq. ft. building in which to minister to kids and teens on a much bigger level than we could have imagined. And after four years of ministry, we have seen God do extraordinary things in the lives of the people in Eastern Kentucky. Because of our obedience to serve Him, we are able to minister through; Club 180, Flip 180, Dance 180, Excel 180, Adventures 180, and Esther's Closet. We now have serving alongside us; Emely Clevinger (Flip 180 Director), Christina Creech (Dance 180 Instructor), Chris Johnson, Steven Lewis, Bobby (June Bug) Lewis, Bobby Lewis, Nick Cornett, Dixie Tolliver, Franklin Baldwin, and will soon be introducing the Quarles family as full-time missionaries to Club 180 Ministry. God has brought many people into this ministry to help design and build Club 180 into what it is now and what is to come. These past four years has not come without it's challenges, but God has brought us through and we have grown both spiritually and emotionally each time. We look forward to what God has planned for this year and we are excited to see what lies ahead.

This year, we are proud to announce that one of our youth workers, Chris Johnson, whom Terry has been discipling the past three years, will be going to college. We are proud because this is a unique situation. No one in his family has ever gone to college. No one has encouraged Chris to go to college. Until this summer, he didn't believe he was smart enough or good enough to go. He has now taken the ACT, filled out Financial Aid, and visited two campuses he is interested in. This young man is so excited that this dream can and will come true! He is an amazing young man who exemplifies faith in Christ and because of that, God is truly blessing his life. We know God is going to use him in extraordinary ways!



We are well into our After School Program (Excel 180) and tutor 10-12 students every Monday - Thursday afternoon. With our full library of every grade level reading available we are helping students make strides in their reading level. We are also offering guitar lessons that Nick Cornett volunteer teaches every Wednesday to six students. Our Excel 180 students will be putting together an Art display within the next month and will hold an Art Exhibit for parents and community. We have amazing young artists!

In February and March we will be hosting two Fund Raisers to help raise money for our Dance 180 Team to purchase warm-up suits. They are practicing hard every Thursday night and are dedicated and excited to be a part of a team. Every week we watch as these girls and boys learn new dance steps and build confidence in who they are. They are not only learning to dance, but they are learning to dance before the Lord, by giving their all to Him.



We have a lot going on within Club 180 Ministry and we need all the support and prayer we can get.
