Building Needs Spring/Summer 2012

Bright Life Farms is a home where mentally or developmentally challenged adults live in a happy, protective and secure environment. We have completed the third home and are looking toward the much needed expansion of the activities building to provide space for 24 residents and staff of the 3 homes. This will be a totally new construction project and will begin with the foundation and the concrete, growing within God's timeline. We have a few tools; labor, funds and/or material needed.

General Supplies Needs Year Round:

Office supplies, (copy paper, envelopes of all sizes, stamps, printer ink), cleaning supplies (Pinesol, bleach, laundry detergents & softeners, dishwashing detergent, garbage bags—13 & 30 gal, spray disinfectant, lg and xlg disposable latex gloves, Windex, Furniture polish), paper products (toilet paper, paper towels, styrofoam cups/plates), food – pantry items always (ex: soups, pasta and sauces, coffee, tea, peanut butter, cereals/oatmeal, beans, canned vegetables and fruit, healthy snacks, juices + milk money!) & personal items (toothbrushes/paste, shampoos, bar soap, deodorant, lotions, Neosporin ointment, bandaids, sunscreen, shaving cream and razors, pj's –lg to 2xlg for men and women, twin bed linens – reg and x-long twin).

Fellowship: Our residents love Bible study and interactions (crafts/games/fellowship/singing) with all age groups. Teams are welcome to come and share with our residents.

A need year round is help with general maintenance, landscaping, painting, clean-up, etc. on all existing areas and buildings.

Can accommodate groups up to 20-25 for 3-5 days. Housing provided at the Farm with shower/bath/kitchen areas. Meals are not provided. Fishing is allowed! Older youth welcomed with adult supervision for smaller projects. 50-amp hook-up available for RV and lots of tent space.

Large and small teams are needed for week long or weekend projects. Everything from Vacation Bible School and Backyard Bible Clubs to block parties, worship, drama, and teams to lead sports camps.

We need teams to support major events for the weekend at the Prisons and Job Corps such as carnivals, picnics for 675 people, and an event called "Returning Hearts" or "Celebrate Life". These events are to bring children and their incarcerated parents together.

Teams are also needed for construction, painting, etc. Construction teams are needed to do light projects in the area. Teams are plugged in according to their giftedness.

The following items are also needed for the ministry: unused "Experiencing God" books, as well as other Books/Study Material For Malachi Dad's and Rubies for Life –Prison programs. We help families with food items, hygiene items, clothing, household items. Also needed are blank DVDs, blank CDs, office products such as paper, envelopes, stamps, tape, etc. Call for exact materials needed.

Help is needed in several new prisons in Ky and Tenn. They need workers and teaching material for the inmates. They also will be ministering to the families of the inmates who will be visiting on in various facilities. They toys for children ages 3-14. Also need people to help minister to these families. Call for more details.

Twelve beds and other areas available for up to 75 people. Kitchens are available.

Bring your own resources for the specific project. Some equipment is available.
